



TRIM-A-THREAD OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

NOTE: It is recommended to operate the drill at below 1000 revs.



1. Fit the Nipple Cutter into an electric or cordless drill.
(Chuck size 3/8) *It is advised to use a fully charged drill if you are using battery power.*
2. Place the tool on the 1/2" (12mm) brass nipple.
3. Tighten the screw which clamps the tool onto the nipple.
4. Activate the drill, applying sufficient pressure to cut the nipple until the drive shaft reaches the stop.
5. Remove the tool by loosening the screw. The nipple is now cut and is the correct length ready for fittings.

KEEP THE TOOL LUBRICATED BY SPRAYING WITH LUBRICANT.

CAUTION: Eye protection should be worn as brass shavings are given off during the cutting operation
